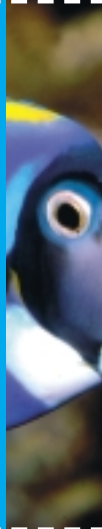

It is the story of four strangers: Anna (Julia Roberts), Dan (Jude Law), Alice (Natalie Portman) and Larry (Clive Owen), their chance meetings, instant attractions and casual betrayals.

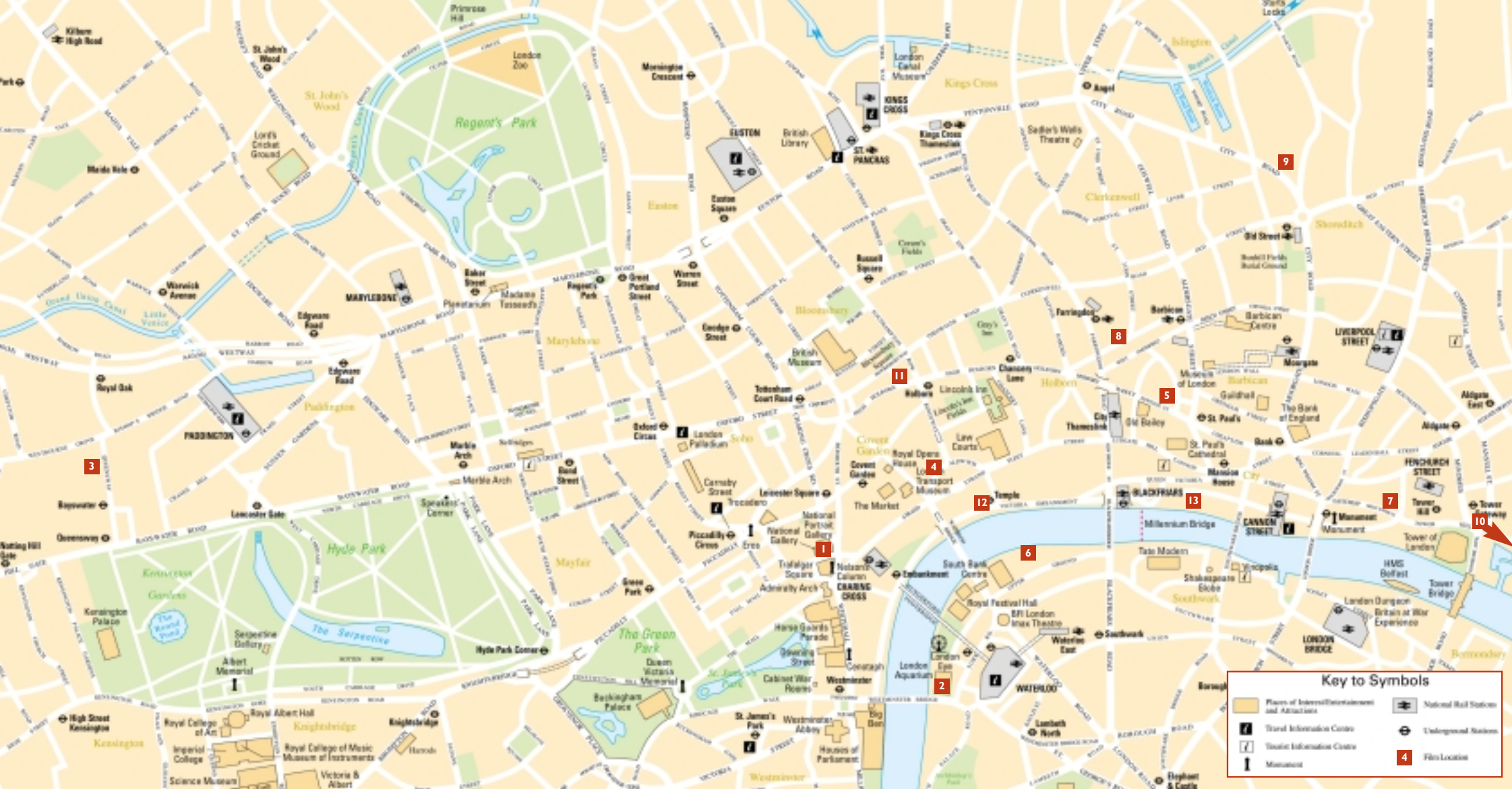

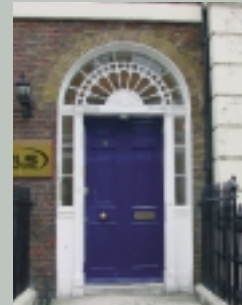

## Did You Know?



- > The Opera House scenes were filmed at **Theatre Royal, Drury Lane**. Designed in 1812 by Benjamin Wyatt, it is the oldest theatre in the world still in use and boasts six bars including the Grand Saloon which features in the movie. Also shot here was Derek Jarman's *Jubilee* (1977) and 1989 comedy *The Tall Guy*.
- > **London Aquarium** is one of the city's top visitor attractions and exhibits exotic aquatic life such as sharks, piranhas, puffins and starfish. In the last year Kate Winslet, Halle Berry, Jonathan Ross and Harry Enfield have all visited the aquarium.
- > The **South Bank** has become one of London's most popular filming locations thanks to its ever-evolving skyline featuring Tate Modern, the British Airways London Eye, National Film Theatre, Millennium Bridge, Oxo Tower, Saatchi Gallery, London Aquarium and City Hall. Recent shoots include *Wimbledon* and *Bride & Prejudice*. *Closer* features the iconic landmarks of St Paul's Cathedral and 30 St Mary Axe (the Gherkin) which can be seen from the South Bank.
- > The gallery exhibiting Anna's photography was shot at **Whiteleys**, London's first real department store and now a modern, luxury shopping centre. Bette Davis does her shopping here in *Connecting Rooms* and Sixties spy thriller *Billian Dollar Brain* starring Michael Caine was also shot here.

- > **18 Southampton Place** is the location that was used for the exterior of Larry's surgery. During filming the door was painted from blue to black and back again afterwards.
- > **Thomas More Square** has become an increasingly popular filming location. The hi-tech office block has stunning rooftop views and was used for the exterior of Dan's newspaper office. Shooting for this scene with Jude Law and Natalie Portman was interrupted with short flurries of snow.
- > The **National Portrait Gallery** is home to the world's greatest collection of portraiture and also the renowned Portrait Restaurant and Bar. With its stunning view of London's skyline, The Portrait Restaurant is one of the capital's most sought after socialising hotspots.
- > The outside of Anna's studio was filmed at **E M Miller & Son Ltd**. This Islington-based printers is just down the street from Jamie Oliver's restaurant Fifteen.
- > **Postman's Park** was opened in 1880. In 1887 Mr G.F.Watts conceived the idea of a national memorial to heroic men and women and dedicated a wall to this cause in 1900. It is here that Alice and Dan begin to fall in love.
- > The scenes outside the hospital were shot at **1 Seething Lane**. A derelict building at the time of shooting this address is currently being transformed into a modern hotel due to open in Summer 2005.
