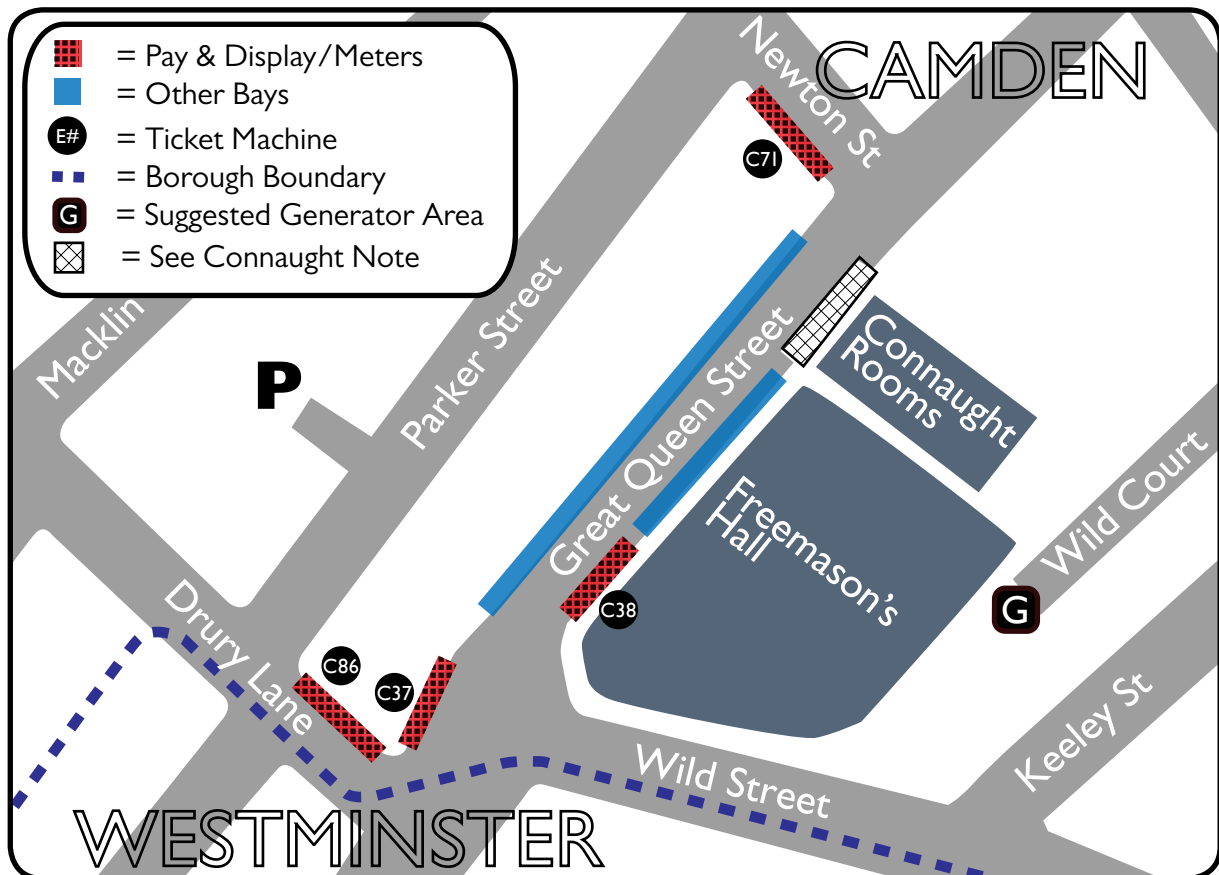


# The United Grand Lodge of England Freemasons Hall

## Technical Vehicle Parking Guidelines



The United Grand Lodge of England Freemasons Hall frequently hosts film shoots.

To continue the good relationship between the hall and the surrounding residences and businesses please consider the following guidelines

The hall falls on the boundary of two boroughs. Please see map.

Applications for parking suspensions and dispensations in connection to filming in the immediate area of the halls should be made to Camden Film Office (note: Wild Street is in Westminster though not suitable for normal tech parking). Contact details below.

Camden Film Office will consider applications to park in the pay and display bays as indicated on the map on Great Queen Street, Drury Lane and Newton Street.

## Technical Vehicle Parking Guidelines

The halls may offer power on site and a genny position at the back of the building (away from residences and businesses) is indicated.

There is an NCP car park for crew cars on Parker Street. Please see map.

The Peabody estate on Wild Street should be informed of the shoot by letter drop. The side entrance to the building coming out on to Wild Street is directly opposite residences. Shoots should not create a disturbance for these residents outside normal hours

Residences on Great Queen Street and affected parts of Drury Lane should be informed of proposed plans by letter drop. Feedback should be invited and reported to Camden Film Office.

Businesses on Great Queen Street and affected parts of Drury Lane should be informed of proposed plans by letter drop and verbally. Feedback should be invited and reported to Camden Film Office.

Large units may consider nearby Lincolns Inn fields as a unit base for which a parking guide is available from Film London.
